Yet this discernment is the very source of spiritual transformation and divine blessing. The discernment of God's presence once gripped men and women of God with a holy fear and hushed reverence. Moses discerned

**Jesus himself drew near, and went with them. But their eyes were holden that they should not know him. Luke 24:15b-16**

that he was in the presence of God when the bush burned and was not consumed. "And Moses hid his face and was afraid to look upon God" (Ex. 3:6). Nevertheless, it is still possible to be in His presence and to remain untouched by the majesty and wonder of His person. To

discern the Lord personally present in our meetings is essential to gathering unto Him.
