There is a time coming when believers will no longer need the bread and the cup to remind them of the Lord Jesus, for they shall be with Him and “behold His face.” The Lord’s supper not only allows the believer to look backward to Calvary to see Him crucified, and upward to heaven to see Him glorified; but he can also look forward to the time when “He that shall come will come,” and take all His people to that home He has prepared for them. Thus anticipation is no small part of the Lord’s supper. Each time believers take the bread and cup, it may be for the last time. Perhaps by the next Lord’s day they shall be all together in His presence, to go no more out.
